Description

APPLICATION OPENS MARCH 15, 2021.

The Perkins V Grant for Career and Technical Education provides funds for approved Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs. In Minnesota, funds are distributed on the basis of state-approved career and technical education programs and appropriate teacher licensure. Programs are administered under Minnesota Rules Chapter 3505 and the federal Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act (Perkins V).

The Minnesota Department of Education (MDE) approves Career and Technical Education Programs (CTE) that meet teacher licensing and other criteria. These programs are eligible to access federal Perkins V funds. Districts that accept these federal dollars must report enrollment and student proficiency for CTE courses and programs to the department.

We are also using our consortium POS to along with regional LMI to plan efforts and focus on the areas where we have great need, and where there are greater opportunities for high wage, high skill and high demand careers. We also think that our consortium emphasis on becoming a poverty informed community will also lead to more opportunities for students to explore career options. We are also working with all three regional Chambers of Commerce (Austin, Albert Lea and Owatonna) to connect to Workforce issues in the region, and from this work we know that the regional employers are concerned with workforce issues.
